



CHANNEL MEN'S SHED INC.
SHED PROPERTY AND EQUIPMENT POLICY

This property and equipment policy applies to all members of the Channel Men's Shed ("the Shed") and is effective from 28th October 2014 and shall remain effective, until it is modified or withdrawn by the Committee.

With the exclusion of:

- loan equipment and
- personal materials brought into the Shed for a personal project,

all property and equipment purchased by or donated to the Shed, is owned by the Shed for the benefit of all members. No individual member owns the property or equipment within the Shed – it is owned by all of the members.

Therefore, Shed members shall not remove any property or equipment belonging to the Shed unless it has first been approved by at least three (3) Committee Members, one of whom must be the member administering and controlling the part of the Shed to which the property or equipment relates.

If agreed to by the Committee Members, the member removing the property and / or equipment shall make a fair and reasonable donation to the Shed, based on the quantity and condition of the property and / or equipment.

In accordance with existing and future Loan Agreements, equipment that is on loan to the Shed shall be removed without the "Owner's express permission".

Should a member want to borrow any property or equipment from the Shed for a short time, similarly it shall require the approval of at least three (3) Committee Members, one of whom must be the member administering and controlling the part of the Shed to which the property or equipment relates.
